SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2967

As Recommended by House Committee on
Appropriations

Brief*

HB 2967 would allow the Adjutant General's Department to reimburse political subdivisions for the cost of health insurance for members of the Kansas National Guard who are activated for state active duty beyond 30 days. The bill would strike language directing the Director of Accounts and Reports to transfer State General Funds to the employer for the cost of the health insurance. The bill would add language allowing the State Finance Council to provide funds for this purpose.

Background

HB 2967 was introduced by the House Committee on Federal and State Affairs. The Comptroller for the Adjutant General's Department testified favorably on the bill. She indicated that this bill would make a technical correction to legislation passed by the 2005 Legislature.

The fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget indicates that this bill would have no fiscal impact.
