RE: Fiscal Year 2012 PEAK Annual Report

The following information is provided to satisfy the annual reporting requirements of K.S.A. 74-50,216 in the Promoting Employment Across Kansas (PEAK) Act.

In 2009, Senate Bill 97 was passed and signed into law creating the PEAK program effective July 1, 2009. Companies that were relocating jobs to Kansas from out of state could retain 95 percent of the withholding taxes generated by the new employees that were paid wages at or above the county wage standard. Legislative changes in 2010 and 2011 broadened the program to also allow companies to qualify that were locating a new business operation or function in Kansas. Additionally, commencing in calendar year 2012, existing Kansas companies were permitted to participate.

Of the 58 companies that signed agreements during FY 2012, 48 had effective dates to commence PEAK benefits and were required to report during that period. Those 48 active participants projected the hiring of 6,552 total jobs and upon creation of the jobs, estimated an additional direct annual payroll of \$374,420,346. Companies estimated capital investment expenditures for these projects at over \$800 million.

In FY 2012, the 48 companies reported the following results:

- 4,005 jobs were added with an overall average wage of \$32.81 hourly.
- Total payroll was \$222,917,320 generating an additional \$9,644,006 in Kansas withholding.
- Of that additional withholding, \$8,892,752 or 92.2%, was retained by the companies for PEAK-eligible employees that were paid at or above the county wage standard.
- \$751,254 or 7.8% of withholding, was remitted to Kansas as the required five percent for PEAK-eligible employees and for PEAK employees whose individual wages did not meet the county wage standard.
- Using industry standard multipliers from the U.S. Department of Commerce, Bureau of Economic Analysis, 5,250 indirect jobs were created and \$194,648,382 of indirect income with \$7,785,935 of additional withholding are estimated to have resulted from the 4,005 jobs and wages reported during FY12.
