

The Kansas Bureau of Investigation is conducting an investigation at the request of the Reno County Sheriff. The incident began last night when Kingman Kansas police officers made contact with a suspect who allegedly fled and a car chase ensued. Officers from the Kingman police department, Kingman county sheriff's office, Kansas Highway patrol, South Hutchinson police department and Reno county sheriff's office were involved in the pursuit. The car chase ended in Reno county. Shots were fired during the incident and the suspect was wounded.

The name and condition of the suspect are not being released at this time but the wound is not believed to be life threatening.

No time estimate has been determined for completing the investigation. When the investigation is complete the KBI will meet with the prosecutorial authorities and a determination will be made at that time on what, if any, charges are appropriate and what additional information can be released.
