

ECONOMIC IMPACT STATEMENT

The economic impact for K.A.R. 66-8-6, K.A.R. 66-10-1, K.A.R. 66-12-1 and K.A.R. 66-14-10 is as follows:

1. There is no anticipated economic impact on the Board of Technical Professions.
2. These regulations are not mandated by federal law as a requirement for participating in or implementing a federally subsidized or assisted program.
3. There may be additional costs to licensees or applicants with the implementation of 66-8-6 and 66-14-10. These costs will be based on the educational choices made by each individual.
