JUVENILE REGISTRATION:

- Adjudicated as a juvenile offender for any crime which if committed by an adult would constitute a sexually violent crime classified as an off-grid or severity level 1 felony:**
- Offender not confined = 5 years from date of adjudication or until the age of 18 whichever is longer, OR
 Offender confined = 5 years from date of release.
- Adjudicated as a juvenile offender for an any crime which if committed by an adult would constitute a sexually violent crime NOT classified as an off-grid or severity level 1 felony - subject to judicial discretion:**
- Option 1:
 Offender not confined = 5 years from date of adjudication or until the age of 18 whichever is longer
 Offender confined = 5 years from date of release;
- Option 2: No registration required by court finding on the record;
- Option 3: Registration as in Option 1 but without public access to registration records.

NONRESIDENT REGISTRATION:
