Reminders:

▶ Be sure to use the **most current version** of any JE. These can always be found on our web site, no matter what year you need. For example, 2008 JE Rev. date 7/1/08 is **NOT** the most current version because of an error (see below), therefore, a revision was reposted on our website with a [current Rev. date 11/10/08](#).

▶ The "**offense date**" determines which version of [Journal Entry of Judgment](#) to use. The new 2009 Journal Entry should be used to journalize crimes committed on or after July 1, 2009. On-line versions are available [from 2005 to present](#). Other versions may be obtained by contacting the Commission.
