

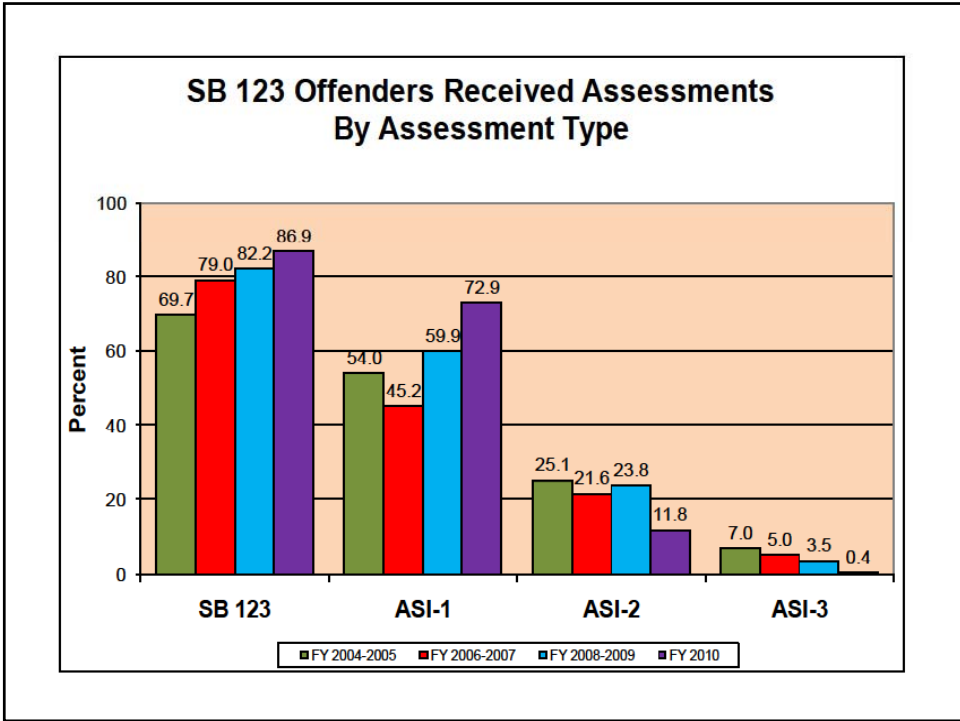
KSC Summary of SB 123 Offenders Received Assessments

SB 123 Assessment Reports

- ❑ As of June 30, 2010, KSC received SB 123 assessment reports of 7,839 offenders, among which,
 - 32 (0.4%) were from FY 2004,
 - 1,390 (17.7%) were from FY 2005,
 - 1,546 (19.7%) were from FY 2006,
 - 1,317 (16.8%) were from FY 2007,
 - 1,305 (16.6%) were from FY 2008,
 - 1,164 (14.8%) were from FY 2009 and
 - 1,085 (13.8) were from FY 2010.



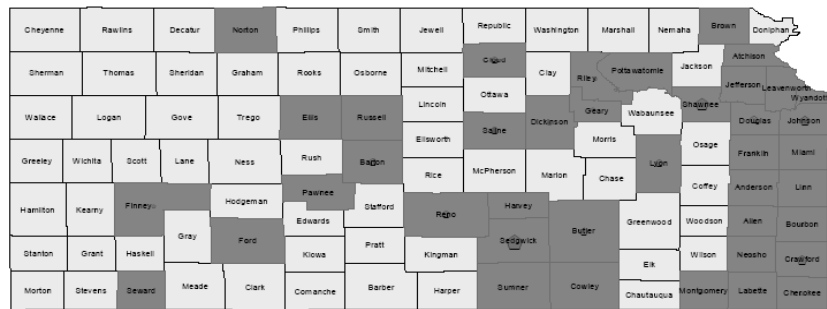

SB 123 Treatment Providers Approved by KDOC as of June 30, 2005

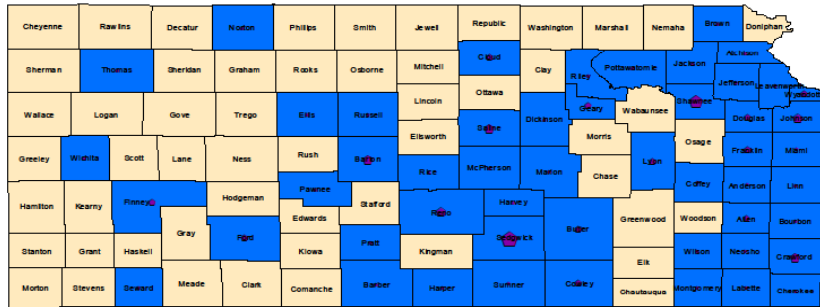

SB 123 Treatment Providers Approved by KDOC as of June 30, 2010

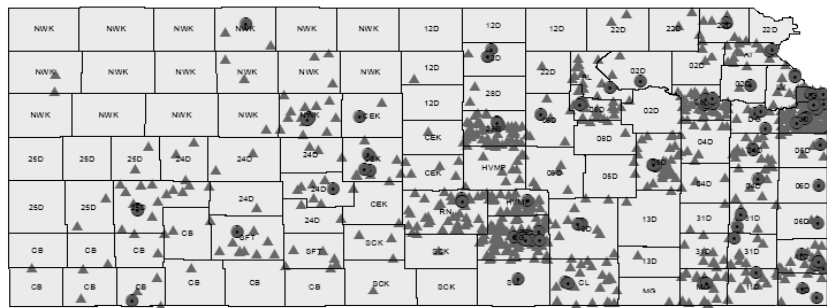

SB 123 Offenders Received Assessments and Treatment Providers By Community Correction As of June 30, 2005

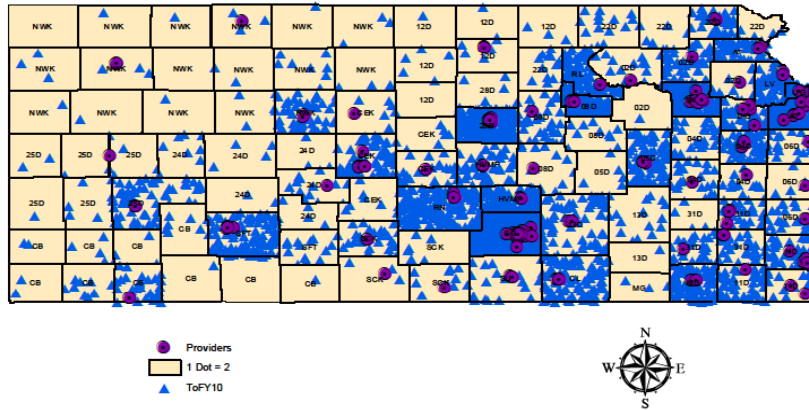

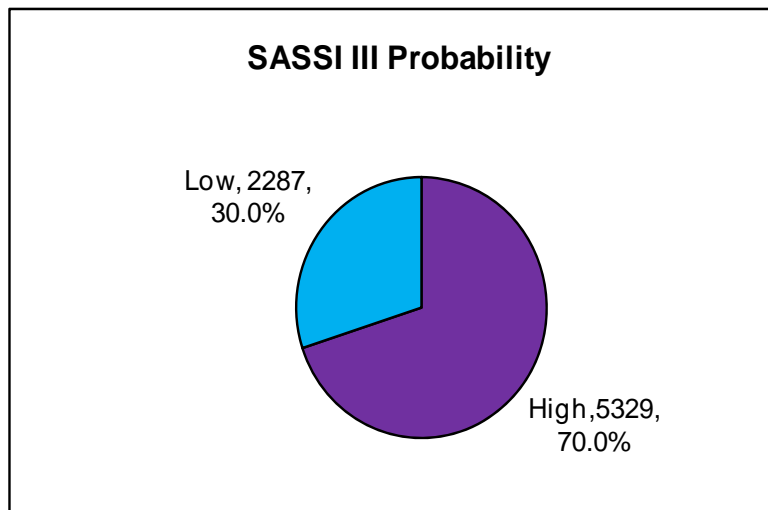

As of June 30, 2010**

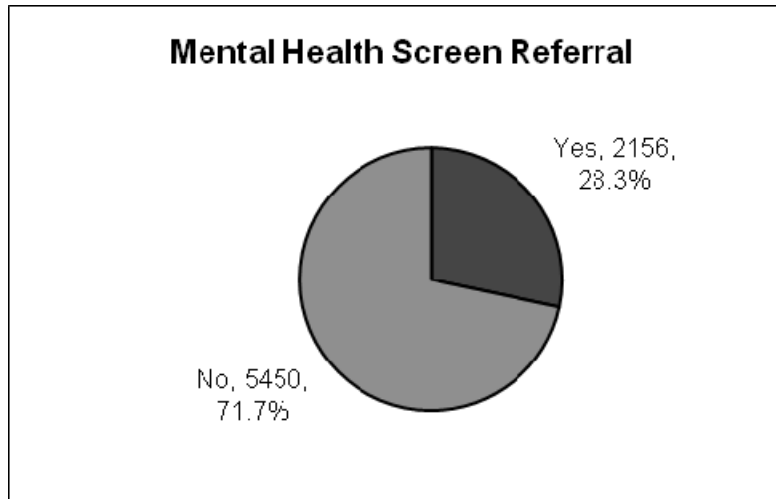

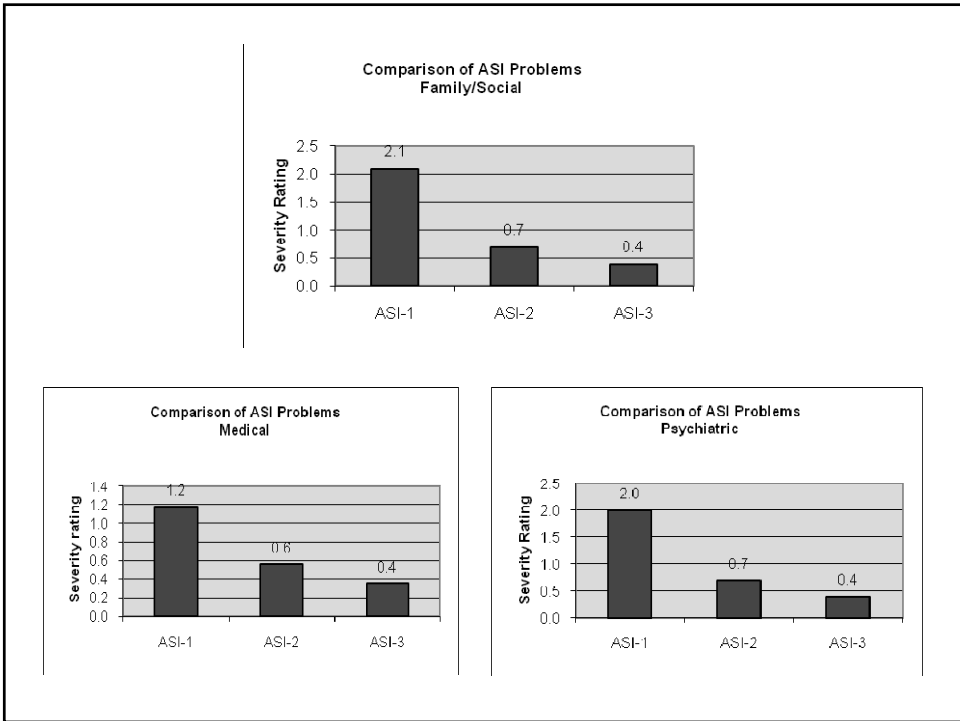
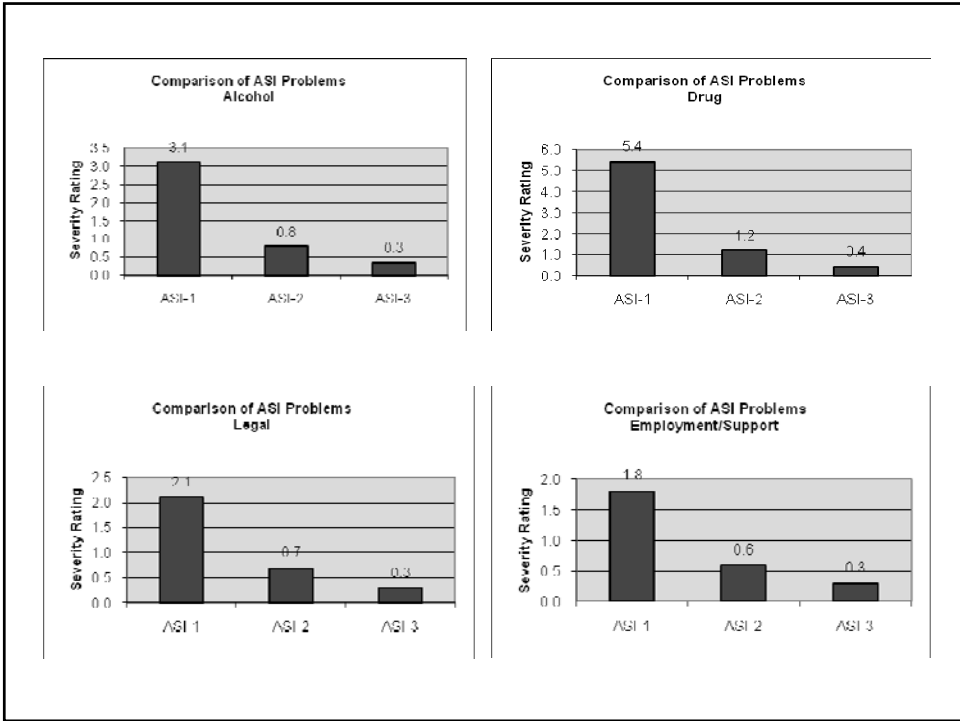

Comparison of the Average Severity Ratings of Three ASIs by Problem

- Paired Samples T test is applied to test the average severity rating differences in each problem area.
- The tests indicate that most of the differences are statistically significant at the significance value less than 0.05.
- These results statistically support the purpose of SB 123 treatment programs.



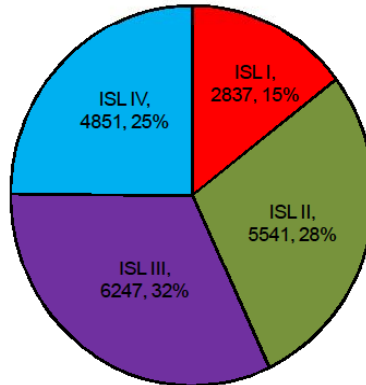
LSI-R© Assessment

- ❑ As of June 30, 2010, the LSI-R has been administered to 7, 973 SB 123 offenders. 5,976 offenders have been assessed 2 or more times.
- ❑ The assessments include
 - 8,026 (41.2%) Pre-sentence/Initial LSI-R's
 - 8,080 (41.5%) Re-assessments and
 - 3,370 (17.3%) Discharge LSI-R's.

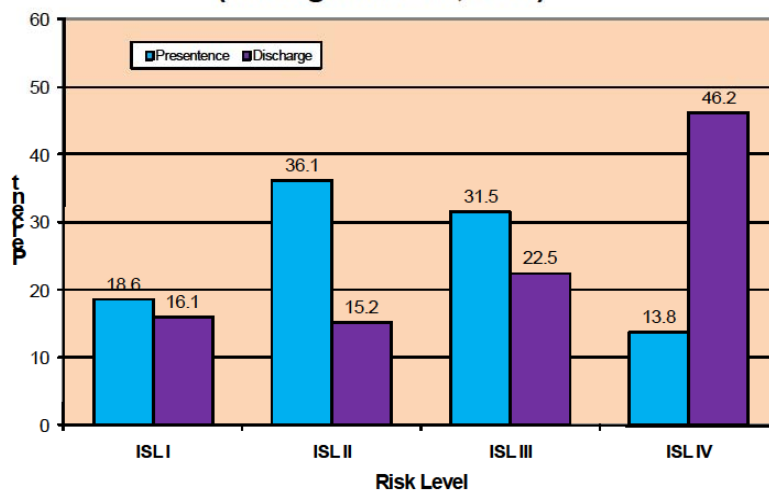
LSI-R© Assessment (cont.)

- ❑ As of June 30, 2010, 19,476 LSI-R's have been administered.
- ❑ Level of Risk/Level of Supervision:
 - 2,837 (14.6%) at ISL I (highest)
 - 5,541 (28.5%) at ISL II
 - 6,247 (32.1%) at ISL III
 - 4,851 (24.9%) at ISL IV (lowest)(3 un-scored were removed from this analysis)
