UPDATE: Statewide Silver Alert issued for missing Andover man

BUTLER COUNTY – The vehicle belonging to David Sawdy was located Saturday at approximately 4:00pm. However, Mr. Sawdy was not with the vehicle and is possibly on foot or picked up. The vehicle was located 1 mile West of the city of Florence on highway 50. The area has been checked by K9's and drones. The Andover Police Department is working with the Marion county Sheriff's office, the Chase county Sherriff's office, the Butler county Sherriff's office, and the Kansas Highway Patrol (KHP) to locate Mr. Sawdy. UPDATE: Statewide Silver Alert issued for missing Andover man

BUTLER COUNTY – The Andover Police Department requested that the Kansas Bureau of Investigation (KBI) issue a statewide Silver Alert for a missing Andover man.

The whereabouts of David Sawdy, 85, are unknown, and the public's assistance is requested to help locate him. He was last heard from on Friday afternoon at 12:00pm on his land phone land at his home in Andover. He was seen on camera headed north on Ridge Rd from 13th Street in Wichita. Sawdy was driving his 2005 Silver Chevy Tahoe with KS tag 14879.

Sawdy is 5 feet 10 inches tall, 150 pounds, gray hair with brown eyes.
