

COSMETOLOGY TRAINING AND LICENSURE REQUIREMENTS:

- Cosmetologist 1500 Clock Hours
- Esthetician 1000 Clock Hours*
- Instructor 300/450 Clock Hours**
- Electrologist 500 Clock Hours (School) or 1000 Clock Hours (Facility Apprenticeship)
- Manicurist 350 Clock Hours***

Board exams are administered in English. Licensure applicants must attain a 75 percent score on each exam, the written and practical. Beginning in 2005 a bloodspill procedure was incorporated into the practical exam.

* Effective July 1, 2009 esthetics hours for licensure increased from 650 clock hours to 1000 clock hours.

**Instructor licensing requires 300 hours if combined with one year of verified work experience as a licensed practitioner. If at least one year work experience cannot be verified, the applicant is required to complete 450 hours. Each instructor license applicant must successfully complete an instructor written exam.

*** Each nail technology licensure applicant must successfully complete the written and practical licensure exams. This includes nail technology applicants who may have acquired licensure in another state.

BODY ART TRAINING AND LICENSURE REQUIREMENTS:

- Kansas body art apprentice training hours are attained under the supervision of a licensed body art trainer in a licensed body art facility.
- Kansas body art licensure requires a minimum of 1200 apprentice hours or 600 hours in a Board approved school.
- Kansas body art licensure requires the successful completion of written and practical exams.
